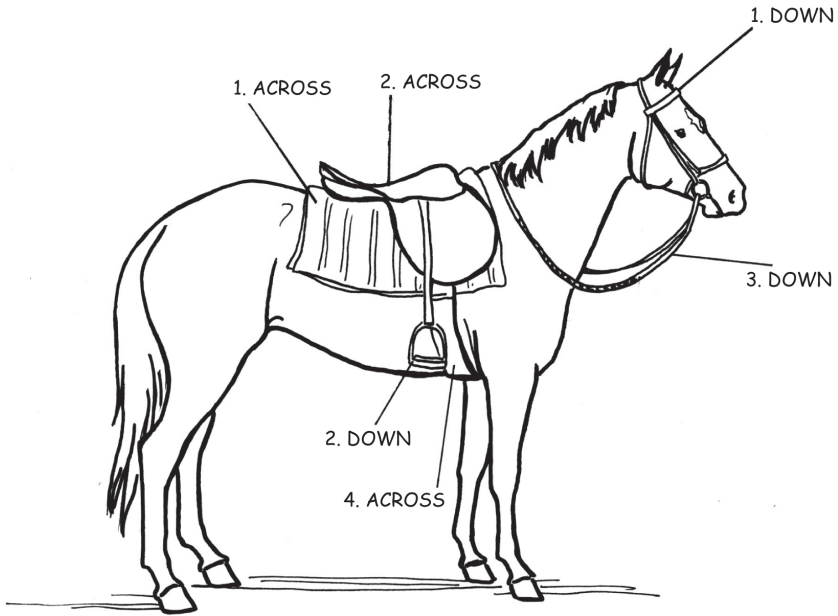
A Dairy Herd is typically made up of four groups of cattle:

- $\overline{3} \overline{15} \overline{23} \overline{19}$ - The females, who give birth to calves and produce milk.
- $\overline{2} \overline{21} \overline{12} \overline{12} \overline{19}$ - The fathers of the dairy herd. Only a few are needed on a dairy farm, though these days most dairy farms use artificial insemination instead.
- $\overline{8} \overline{5} \overline{9} \overline{6} \overline{5} \overline{18} \overline{19}$ - Young female cattle. They are the 'teenagers' of the herd and haven't had a calf or have had one calf only.
- $\overline{3} \overline{1} \overline{12} \overline{22} \overline{5} \overline{19}$ - Baby cattle. Female calves grow into heifers and then milking cows.

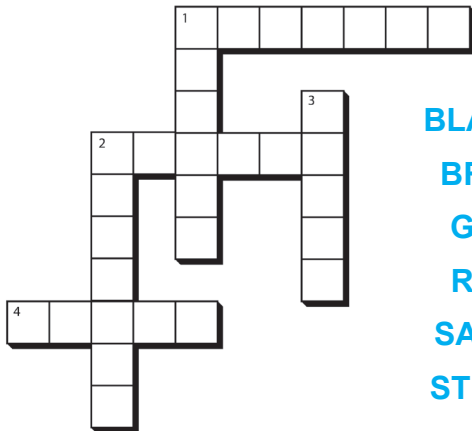

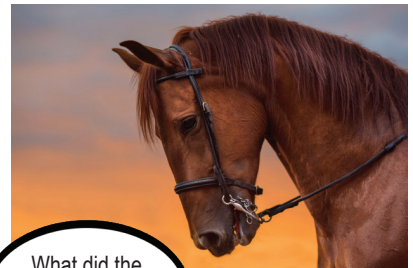

Why do ducks have webbed feet?

Diving ducks and sea ducks search for food fairly deep underwater.

Ducks are omnivores. They feed on aquatic plants, small fish, insects, worms, grubs and more.

Mallard ducks live 5 to 10 years in the wild and 8+ years in captivity.

INTERESTING

A male duck is called a drake, a female duck a hen, and a baby duck a duckling.

All ducks have highly waterproof feathers due to the feathers interlocking nature and waxy coating.

All domestic ducks are descended from either the Mallard or the Muscovy duck.

DUCK FACTS

Ducks have featured as popular cartoon characters over the years, such as Walt Disney's Donald Duck and Warner Brothers, Daffy Duck.

Dabbling ducks feed on the surface of water, on land, or by ducking their head underwater.

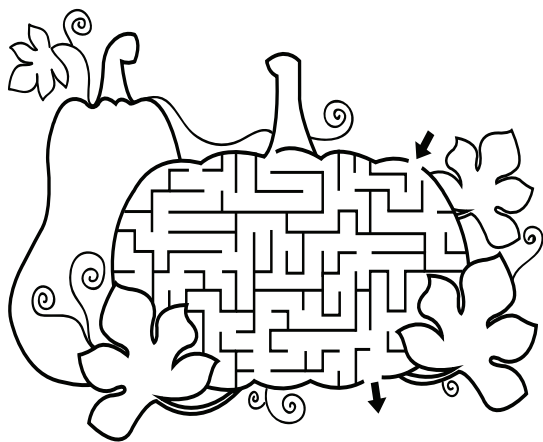
Ducks are mostly aquatic birds living in both fresh water and sea water and found on every continent except for Antarctica.

The name pumpkin comes from the Greek word 'pepon', meaning 'large melon'.

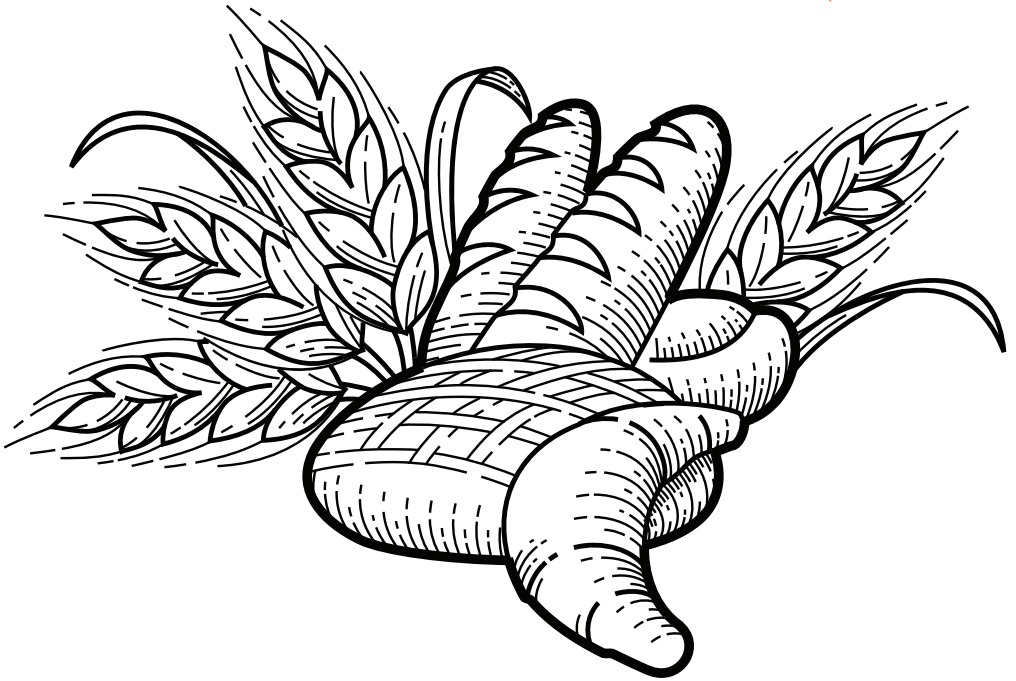
Giant pumpkins can be grown for competitions, with some weighing over 450 kilograms.

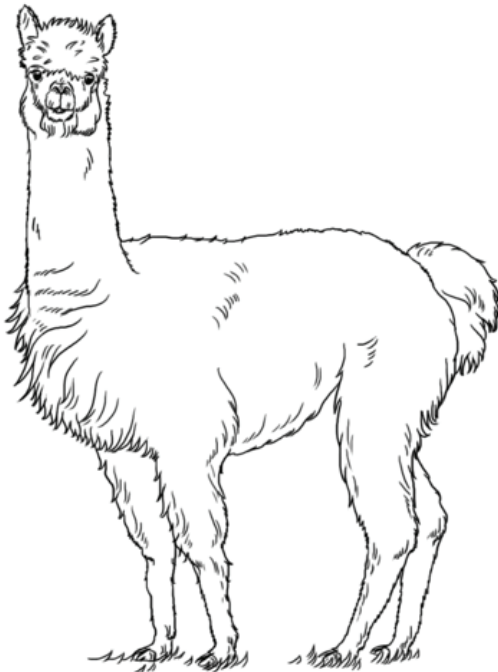

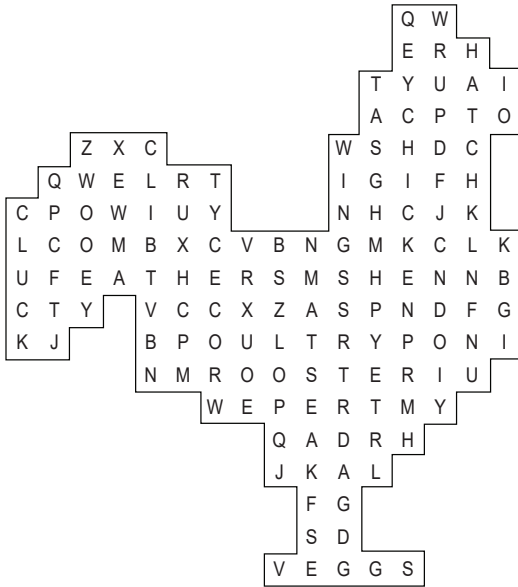

Eggs can be brown or white. The quality and nutrients of brown and white eggs are the same

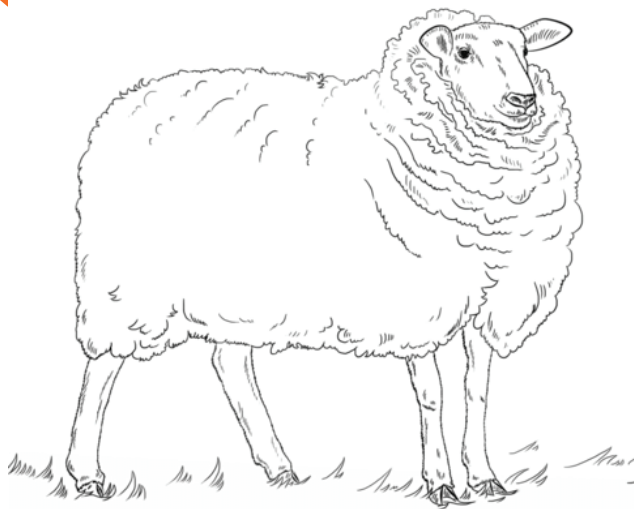
Yolk colour depends on the diet of the hen

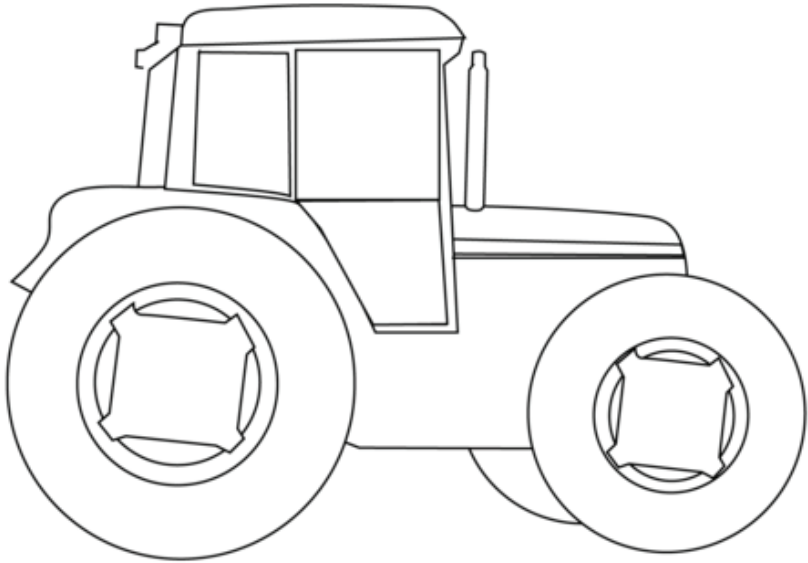

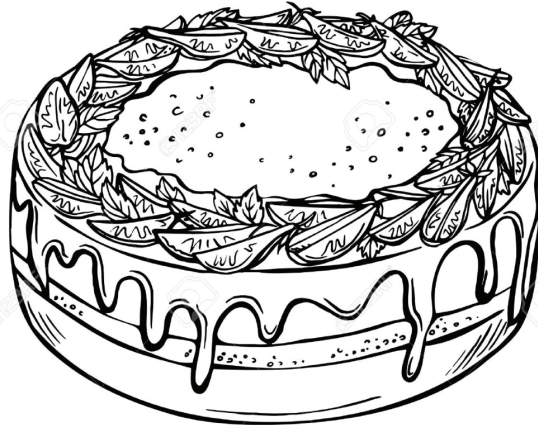
INTERESTING FACTS

Agriculture would not be what it is today without tractors. Farming completely changed from the moment tractors were introduced on the market. Without tractors, we would be short on food supplies. In the past, horses were the main force that dragged heavy things, but today farmers get to choose from a wide range of implements used in farming, construction and other industrial workplaces. Tractor front end loaders feature greater lift height, heavy lift capacity and an attach system for implements that help get different agricultural tasks done quickly and more efficiently.

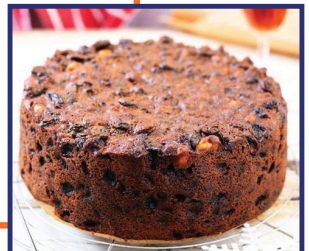

BOILED FRUIT CAKE RECIPE

Ingredients:	250g Sultanas
250g Butter	500g Raisins
250g Brown Sugar	250g Dates
5 Eggs	125g Currants
½ Cup Water	62g Mixed Peel
½ Cup Rum or Brandy	62g Cherries

Put all the above ingredients into a saucepan and bring to the boil, stirring occasionally. Remove from the heat and add grated rind of ½ a lemon and ½ an orange, ½ tablespoon of golden syrup, ½ teaspoon of bicarb soda.

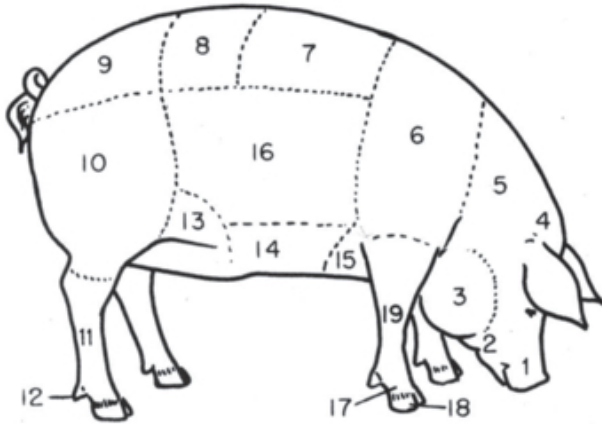
Empty into a bowl and stand overnight. Add 5 beaten eggs alternately with 500g plain flour and ½ cup of self-raising flour, sifted with a pinch of salt. Place mixture into a 20cm prepared tin and bake at 140 degrees for 3 ¼ - 4 hours, depending on your oven.
