Judges are appointed by the Produce Subcommittee of the Society. Only authorised persons shall be allowed in the vicinity of the judges whilst judging. The Judge will only award prizes to Exhibits which are considered to possess sufficient merit. Stewards reserve the right to reject any Exhibit as "not per schedule". The Most Successful Exhibitor must be chosen from prize winners. Points to determine the Most Successful Exhibitor overall are awarded as follows: 3 points for a Best Exhibit, 3 points for a Champion, 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 1 point for 3rd. In the event of a tie, the winner is the one with the most 1st prizes.
