

WHAT WILL BE EXPECTED OF SCHOOLS?



TEAT TO TABLE MILKING DEMONSTRATIONS

Let us take you on a journey from the teat of a cow to actually tasting butter made from cream in 20 minutes. Aimed at showing kids that milk and butter does not come from a supermarket shelf and the interactive butter churning also keeps the adults interested. 5 people in the crowd will also make their own butter by shaking a jar with cream and 2 secret ingredients. You can then taste the butter while learning some facts about the dairy industry.

Kids of all ages can also milk Mootilda, our wooden cow with life like teats full of water instead of milk, in between the sessions. Great for squirting Mum and Dad.
